



Get Assistance with CMMC 2.0 Compliance Funding through the CyberSmart Program

Phase 1

Start the NIST 800-171 rev 2 gap analysis report process at a pre-negotiated discounted cost of \$1,500 as the first step toward compliance and Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC).

The gap analysis provides information to complete the POA&M, SSP, submit to SPRS, and other requirements.

Phase 2

After completing a Phase 1 gap analysis, up to \$22,500 in grant funding (\$7,500 paid by client) is available to remediate compliance deficiencies and to upgrade cybersecurity infrastructure.

Phase 3

Get technical assistance for remediation tasks beyond Phase 1 & 2.

Phase 1 & 2

- Michigan companies who are currently doing business with the DoD
- Existing DoD prime contractor or subcontractor

Phase 3

- Registered in system for award management as a Michigan company
- In good standing with the State of Michigan
- A standardized gap analysis report from the Michigan Defense Center Vendor Referral List (LaScala)
- Average Bid Targeting System (BTS) score of at least 50
- Completed Plan of Action & Milestones (POA&M) and System Security Plan (SSP)
- BTS firm profile updated with the Self-Certification box checked showing NIST Compliance

Businesses that are part of a DoD supply chain that must implement the NIST 800-171 rev 2 compliance.
